

ORDER OF THE
STATE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION
AMENDING RULES

The state superintendent of public instruction hereby repeals PI 6.05 and PI 6.06 (2), (5) and (7) through (11), renumbers PI 6.01 and Subch. II (title), amends PI 6.06 (title), (3) and (6)(a), repeals and recreates Subch. I (title) and creates PI 6.01, Subch. II (title) and Subch. III (title), relating to public libraries.

ANALYSIS BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION

Statutory authority: ss. 43.09(1) and (2), 43.24(2)(n) and 227.11(2)(a), Stats.

Statute interpreted: ss. 43.09, 43.24 and 43.17(5), Stats.

Currently, s. PI 6.05 specifies organizational requirements for provisional certification of public library systems meeting the standards for population set in s. 43.15(1), Stats. Under s. 43.15(1)(b), Stats., no new system may be established nor may a system be continued under temporary certification containing territory having a total population of less than 85,000; therefore, s. PI 6.05 is no longer necessary and has been repealed.

The equitable formula for financial support under s. PI 6.06(2) is no longer necessary since it is now specified under s. 43.15(2), Wis. Stats.

Subsection PI 6.06(5), which requires public library systems to designate a public library in a city of at least 30,000 as its headquarters library or contract with a public library in a city of at least 30,000 to serve as its resource library is deleted because the changes in s. 43.15(1), Stats., and the addition of s. 43.16, Stats., make these provisions obsolete.

The requirements listed in s. PI 6.06(7) through (11) are no longer necessary since similar language has been incorporated in s. 43.24, Stats.

Other minor amendments have been made in order to clarify ch. PI 6.

SECTION 1. Subchapter I (title) of chapter PI 6 is repealed and recreated to read:

SUBCHAPTER I
GENERAL PROVISIONS

SECTION 2. PI 6.01 is renumbered PI 6.02

SECTION 3. PI 6.01 is created to read:

PI 6.01 PURPOSE. This chapter sets forth requirements and grades of certification an individual must hold in order to be an administrator of a municipal, joint and county public library. In addition, this chapter sets requirements for public library systems and determines reimbursement rates for the costs of providing interlibrary borrowing services.

SECTION 4. Subchapter II (title) of chapter PI 6 is renumbered Subchapter IV.

SECTION 5. Subchapter II (title) of chapter PI 6 is created to read:

SUBCHAPTER II

PUBLIC LIBRARIAN CERTIFICATION

NOTE TO REVISOR: Subchapter II (title) to be inserted in front of s. PI 6.03.

SECTION 6. PI 6.05 is repealed.

SECTION 7. Subchapter III (title) of chapter PI 6 is created to read:

SUBCHAPTER III

PUBLIC LIBRARY SYSTEMS

NOTE TO REVISOR: Subchapter III (title) to be inserted in front of s. PI 6.06.

SECTION 8. PI 6.06 (title), (3) and (6)(a) are amended to read:

PI 6.06(title) REQUIREMENTS FOR PUBLIC LIBRARY SYSTEMS.

(3) PLANS FOR USE OF STATE AID. Annually, a system shall file a plan for the use of the state aid it will receive. In a federated system such plan shall indicate the funds to be used by the system for system services, ~~and the funds, if any, to be used for distribution among designated libraries in the system, showing how such distribution will contribute to the system plan of services.~~


(6) (a) Maintain all official records at the system headquarters-library or administrative headquarters ~~at all times~~ for at least 10 years.

SECTION 9. PI 6.06 (2), (5), (7), (8), (9), (10), and (11) are repealed.

SECTION 10. PI 6.06(3), (4) and (6) are renumbered PI 6.06(2), (3) and (4), respectively.

The rules contained in this order shall take effect on the first day of the month commencing after the date of publication in the Wisconsin Administrative Register, as provided in s. 227.22 (2) (intro.), Stats.
