ORDER

An order of the Examining Board of Architects, Professional Engineers, Designers and Land Surveyors to amend A-E 4.05 (1) and Figure 4.05 (1) and to create A-E 4.05 (4) of the administrative code relating to experience equivalents for registration as a professional engineer.

Analysis prepared by the Department of Regulation and Licensing.

ANALYSIS

Statutes authorizing promulgation: ss. 15.08 (5) (b) and 227.11 (2), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: s. 443.04, Stats.

Under current law one of the criterion for professional engineer registration is submission of satisfactory evidence to the Professional Engineers Section of the Examining Board of Architects, Professional Engineers, Designers and Land Surveyors that the applicant has at least 4 years of experience in engineering work of a character satisfactory to the Professional Engineers Section.

This proposed rule-making order allows the applicant to apply up to one year of his or her engineering "cooperative experience" toward satisfying the experience equivalent for registration as a professional engineer. Engineering "cooperative experience" is experience gained during the course of an engineering student's academic training in an approved program established as part of a joint or cooperative arrangement between the engineering school or college and participating employers.

TEXT OF RULE

SECTION 1. A-E 4.05 (1) and Figure 4.05 (1) are amended to read:

A-E 4.05 (1) For the purpose of meeting experience requirements for registration as a professional engineer in s. 443.04 (1), Stats., an applicant may claim certain education as equivalent to experience in engineering as provided in s. 443.04 (2), Stats. The engineer section grants an experience equivalent for education according to the table shown in figure 4.05 (1).

SECTION 2. A-E 4.05 (4) is created to read:

A-E 4.05 (4) To obtain equivalent work experience credit for completion of a cooperative educational program, an applicant shall submit a record of work completed in the cooperative educational program with an application for registration. The engineer section shall determine the amount of equivalent experience awarded for completion of a cooperative educational program by evaluating the record of work completed using the criteria in s. A-E 4.03. No more than 1 year of equivalent experience credit may be awarded under this subsection.
