<u>ORDER</u>

An order of the Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board to repeal BC 9.01 (2) (a) and (b); to renumber and amend BC 9.01 (2) (intro.); to amend BC 9.01 (1); and to create BC 9.01 (3) of the administrative code relating to reinstatement of a credential expired for 5 years or longer.

ANALYSIS

Statutes authorizing promulgation: ss. 15.08 (5) (b) and 227.11 (2), Stats., and s. 440.08 (3) (b), Stats., as created by SECTION 3305 of 1991 Wisconsin Act 39.

Statutes interpreted: s. 440.08 (3) (b), Stats.

In this proposed order, the Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board amends a rule relating to the reinstatement of an expired license to conform to the repeal of s. 454.11, Stats., and the creation of s. 440.08(3), Stats., by 1991 Wisconsin Act 39, and creates a rule requiring the successful completion of the initial licensing examination for reinstatement of licenses which have been expired for a period of 5 years or longer, in accordance with 1991 Wisconsin Act 39.

TEXT OF RULE

SECTION 1. BC 9.01 (1) is amended to read:

BC 9.01 (1) If the application for renewal is filed less than one-year <u>30</u> days after the expiration of the applicant's last license, the applicant may renew the license by payment of the fees as specified in $s_{-}440.05$ (3)-and-(4) e_{τ} -(5), s. 440.08 (2) (a) 5, 18, 20, 30, or 46, and 440.08 (3) (a) 1, Stats.

SECTION 2. BC 9.01 (2) (intro.) is renumbered BC 9.01 (2) and amended to read:

BC 9.01 (2) If the application for renewal is filed more-than-one-year and-less-than-4-years 30 days or more, but less than 5 years after the expiration of the applicant's last license, the applicant may renew the license by completion-of-8-hours-of-practical-training-for-each-year-which-the applicant-was-not-licensed-and-by payment of the fees $\{as\}$ specified in s-440-05-(3)-and-(4)-or-(5) s. 440.08 (2) (a) 5, 18, 20, 30, or 46, and 440.08(3) (a) 2, Stats.

SECTION 3. BC 9.01 (2) (a) and (b) are repealed.

SECTION 4. BC 9.01 (3) is created to read:

BC 9.01 (3) If the application for renewal is 5 years or more after the expiration of the applicant's last license, the applicant may renew the license by completing the requirements for obtaining an initial license under s. 454.06 (2), (3), (4), (5), or (6), Stats.
