ORDER

An order of the Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board to amend BC 4.02 (1) and (2) and 4.03 (1) and to create BC 4.10 of the administrative code relating to manicuring instruments.

Analysis prepared by the Department of Regulation and Licensing.

ANALYSIS

Statutes authorizing promulgation: ss. 15.08 (5) (b) and 227.11 (2) (a), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: s. 454.08 (4), Stats.

In this order the Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board clarifies the standard of cleaning and disinfection for manicuring instruments necessary to reduce the risk of transmission of blood borne pathogens.

These proposed rules specify that all reusable manicuring instruments be treated as instruments that pierce the skin of the patron and amend the specifications for disinfectants. It is therefore required that these instruments be cleaned and thoroughly disinfected or sterilized between each use.

TEXT OF RULE

SECTION 1. BC 4.02 (1) and (2) are amended to read:

BC 4.02 (1) Prior to use, all scissors, razors, clipper blades, tweezers, ~~reusable-manicure-instruments~~ and all other cutting instruments contaminated by contact with blood shall be cleaned with soap or detergent and water, dried, and disinfected ~~by-total-immersion-in-70%-isopropyl-alcohol-for-at-least-10-minutes-and-then-air-dried~~ with a disinfectant registered with the United States environmental protection agency as a tuberculocidal agent, used in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions. Alcohol Disinfectant used for decontamination shall be changed daily and shall be kept in a covered container.

(2) Clipper blades, razors, scissors, tweezers, ~~reusable-manicure instruments~~ and all other cutting instruments not contaminated by contact with blood shall be cleaned and disinfected prior to use. Disinfection may be accomplished ~~by-immersion~~ as described in sub. (1), ~~by-use-of-alcohol-wipe~~, or by use of an EPA-registered germicidal spray with demonstrated bactericidal, fungicidal and virucidal activity used according to manufacturer's instructions.

SECTION 2. BC 4.03 (1) is amended to read:

BC 4.03 STERILIZATION. (1) Sterilization, as required by ss. BC 4.07, and 4.09 and 4.10 shall be accomplished by use of a FDA-registered dry or steam sterilizer, used according to manufacturer's instructions.

SECTION 3. BC 4.10 is created to read:

BC 4.10 MANICURING. (1) Licensees performing manicuring shall:

(a) Prior to use, disinfect or sterilize reusable manicure instruments.

(b) Disinfection shall be accomplished with a disinfectant registered with the United States environmental protection agency as a tuberculocidal agent, used in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions. Disinfectant used for decontamination shall be changed daily and shall be kept in a covered container.

(c) Sterilization shall be accomplished in accordance with s. BC 4.03.

(2) Manicure instruments that cannot be cleaned and disinfected or sterilized shall be disposed of following each use.

The rules adopted in this order shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register pursuant to s. 227.22 (2) (intro.), Stats.
