CHIROPRACTIC EXAMINING BOARD : ADOPTING RULES

: (CLEARINGHOUSE RULE 92-172)

ORDER

An order of the Chiropractic Examining Board to repeal Chir 5.01 (1) (intro.); to renumber Chir 5.01 (1) (a); and to amend Chir 2.025, 3.06, and 6.02 (7) of the administrative code relating to the retention of licensure application files by the board, definitions of unprofessional conduct, the requirement that doctors of chiropractic use a professional title, and continuing education requirements for renewal of a credential to practice chiropractic.

Analysis prepared by the Department of Regulation and Licensing.

ANALYSIS

Statutes authorizing promulgation: ss. 15.08 (5), and 227.11 (2) (a), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: ss. 16.61 (4) (a), 446.02 (2), and 446.04, Stats.

In this order the Chiropractic Examining Board proposes to:

- (1) Amend s. Chir 2.025 for consistency with the statutes providing that application forms filed with the board are state property which may not be returned to the person filing them.
- (2) Amend s. Chir 3.06 requiring doctors of chiropractic to use particular identifying titles whenever the chiropractor uses the prefix "Dr." as a professional title.
- (3) Repeal s. Chir 5.01 (1) (intro.) and renumber Chir 5.01 (1) (a) specifying the continuing education hours required for license periods prior to 1993.
- (4) Amend s. Chir 6.02 (7) defining unprofessional conduct to include engaging in inappropriate sexual contact, exposure, gratification, or other sexual behavior with or in the presence of a patient.

TEXT OF RULE

SECTION 1. Chir 2.025 is amended to read:

Chir 2.025 <u>TIME FOR COMPLETING APPLICATIONS AND TAKING EXAMINATION.</u> An application is incomplete until all materials described in s. Chir 2.02 are filed with the board. All application materials described in s. Chir 2.02 shall be filed with the board within one year from the date the first item is filed. If an application is incomplete for more than one year, or if an applicant fails to take an examination within one year from the date the application is complete, all-application-materials-shall-be-returned-to-the applicant-by-the-department-and the applicant shall begin the application process anew in order to take the examination for a license as a chiropractor.

SECTION 2. Chir 3.06 is amended to read:

Chir 3.06 <u>PROFESSIONAL TITLE</u>. A licensee shall use the suffix; "D.C." or "Chiropractor" immediately following his or her surname for proper identification if-the-prefix-"Dr."-is-used-as-a-professional-title.

SECTION 3. Chir 5.01 (1) (intro.) is repealed.

SECTION 4. Chir 5.01 (1) (a) is renumbered Chir 5.01 (1).

SECTION 5. Chir 6.02 (7) is amended to read:

Chir 6.02 (7) Engaging in sexual intimacies-with-patients-in-the-office contact, exposure, gratification, or other sexual behavior with or in the presence of a patient.
