

ORDER

An order of the Pharmacy Examining Board to amend Phar 10.03 (17) and to create Phar 10.03 (18) of the administrative code relating to standards of professional conduct.

Analysis prepared by the Department of Regulation and Licensing.

ANALYSIS

Statutes authorizing promulgation: ss. 15.08 (5) (b), 227.11 (2) and 450.02 (2), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: s. 450.10, Stats.

In this proposed rule-making order the Pharmacy Examining Board is amending s. Phar 10.03 (17) to include as violations of standards of professional conduct having had other disciplinary action taken by the licensing authority. The board is also creating s. Phar 10.03 (18). This subsection was inadvertently deleted from previous rule-making of the board (Clearinghouse Rule 89-150) which was effective September 1, 1991.

TEXT OF RULE

SECTION 1. Phar 10.03 (17) is amended to read:

Phar 10.03 (17) Having a pharmacist license revoked or suspended in another state or United States jurisdiction; or, having been subject to other disciplinary action by the licensing authority thereof;

SECTION 2. Phar 10.03 (18) is created to read:

Phar 10.03 (18) Violating or attempting to violate any formal disciplinary order of the board.
