ORDER

An order of the Department of Regulation and Licensing to repeal RL 4.03 (2); to renumber RL 4.03 (3), (4) and (5); to amend Figure 4.04 (4); and to create RL 4.04 (5) of the administrative code relating to fees for examinations and reexaminations, fees for proctoring examinations, and refund fees.

Analysis prepared by the Department of Regulation and Licensing.

ANALYSIS

Statutes authorizing promulgation: ss. 15.08 (5) (b), 227.11 (2), 440.03 (2), 440.06 and 440.07 (3), Stats., and s. 440.05 (1) as amended by SECTION 3291 of 1991 Wisconsin Act 39.

Statutes interpreted: ss. 440.03 (2) and 440.05 (1), Stats.

Section RL 4.04 (5) is created relating to fees for proctoring examinations for Wisconsin applicants who are applying for a credential in another state.

The fees for animal technicians, nursing home administrators and pharmacists are updated to reflect increased charges by the test provider. The fee for a new examination for physicians, SPEX, is added. The fee for physician's assistants is amended to comply with 1991 Wisconsin Act 39.

TEXT OF RULE

SECTION 1. RL 4.03 (2) is repealed.

SECTION 2. RL 4.03 (3), (4) and (5) are renumbered (2), (3) and (4).
