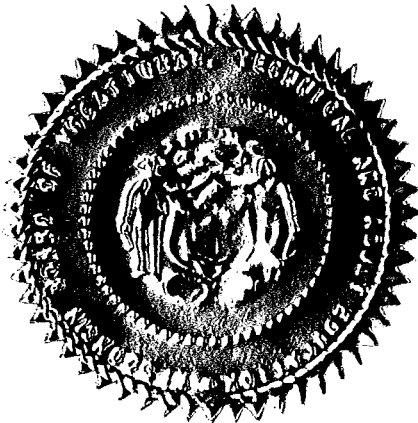

PROPOSED ORDER
OF THE
WISCONSIN BOARD OF VOCATIONAL, TECHNICAL AND ADULT EDUCATION
ADOPTING RULE AMENDMENT TO AUTHORIZE VTAE CERTIFICATION OF
DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION SECONDARY INSTRUCTORS
(Clearinghouse Rule 93-29)

1 The Wisconsin Board of Vocational, Technical and Adult Education proposes to
2 amend ch. VTAE 3.03(9) relating to the certification of nondistrict
3 educational personnel.

PLAIN LANGUAGE ANALYSIS PREPARED BY THE
BOARD OF VOCATIONAL, TECHNICAL AND ADULT EDUCATION

Statutory authority: s. 38.04(4)(a), Stats.
Statutes interpreted: ss. 38.001(3)(a) and 38.04(4)(a), Stats.

Pursuant to ss. 38.04(4)(a) and 38.001(3)(a), Wis. Stats., the Board of Vocational, Technical and Adult Education ("board") has authority to approve the qualifications of educational personnel involved in the delivery of vocational, technical and adult education and to contract with secondary schools to provide educational opportunities for high school age students.

This order provides a procedure to grant certification to public high school instructors. Specifically, the rule amendment provides that secondary school instructors certified by the department of public instruction may receive certification from the vocational, technical and adult education system for teaching high school courses which are identified as technical college introductory level occupational or occupational-related.

1 Section 1. Chapter VTAE 3.03(9) is amended to read:

5 VTAE 3.03(9) CERTIFICATION OF NONDISTRICT EDUCATIONAL STAFF.

7 (a) The department of corrections and the department of health and social
8 services, including the division of youth services and the division of care
9 and treatment facilities, may request certification from the board for
10 employes who provide instruction for which district credit may be granted, and
11 shall pay the costs associated with processing such requests.



13 (b) K-12 school districts may request certification from the board for
14 secondary school instructors and shall pay the costs associated with
15 processing such requests. Eligibility for certification granted under this
16 paragraph shall be determined by the board based on consideration of factors
17 including the secondary instructor's current certification by the department
18 of public instruction; a determination that the high school course for which
19 certification is sought is technical college introductory level occupational
20 or occupational related; and a determination that enrollment in the course is
21 limited to secondary students who have demonstrated a mastery of relevant
22 prerequisite competencies. The certification eligibility factors shall be
23 demonstrated in articulation agreements between the technical colleges and the
24 secondary schools. Certification granted shall be for one academic year, or
25 portion thereof, and may be renewed.

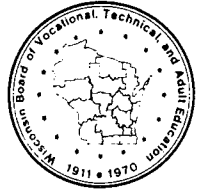
