IN THE MATTER OF a rule AMENDING chapter Trans 503, Wisconsin Administrative Code, relating to the motor cycle safety program.

ORDER ADOPTING RULE

Analysis Prepared by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation

STATUTORY AUTHORITY: s. 85.30, Stats.

STATUTE INTERPRETED: s. 85.30, Stats.

General Summary of Rule. Most Motorcycle Rider Education Course providers are experiencing increased enrollments and are running more cost effective courses, mostly because course costs are being spread out over more students. This is causing student fees to cover in excess of 40% of actual course costs. This rule deletes the reference that sponsors may not be reimbursed for courses if students are required to pay more than 40% of actual course costs. Current reimbursement level is 70% of actual course costs or total course costs minus student fees collected, whichever is less.

Fiscal Estimate. No fiscal impact is anticipated from this rule making.

Final Regulatory Flexibility Analysis. This rule will have no significant adverse impact on small businesses.

TEXT OF RULE

Under the authority vested in the state of Wisconsin, department of transportation, by s. 85.30, Stats., the department of transportation hereby amends a rule interpreting s. 85.30, Stats., relating to the motorcycle safety program.

SECTION 1. Trans 503.04(4)(c) is amended to read:

Trans 503.04(4)(c) Reimbursement under this subsection may not exceed 70% of the actual course cost. ~~No reimbursement may be provided under this subsection for a course for which the students are required to pay more than 40% of the actual course costs.~~ Reimbursement

may not exceed an amount equal to actual course cost less the amount students are required to pay.

(END OF RULE TEXT)

Effective Date. This rule shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin Administrative Register as provided in s. 227.22 (2), Stats.

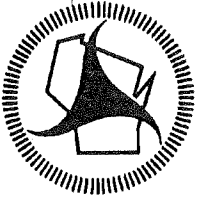
