ORDER

An order of the Funeral Directors Examining Board to create FDE 3.02 (17) of the administrative code relating to a violation of a board order constituting unprofessional conduct.

Analysis prepared by the Department of Regulation and Licensing.

ANALYSIS

Statutes authorizing promulgation: ss. 15.08 (5) (b), 227.11 (2) and 445.03 (2) (a), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: ss. 445.12 and 445.13 (1), Stats.

In this proposed rule-making order the Funeral Directors Examining Board creates a rule relating to funeral directors who violate or attempt to violate a board order. Such violation or attempt to do so constitutes unprofessional conduct.

Section FDE 3.02 sets forth what constitutes unprofessional conduct by a licensed funeral director.

TEXT OF RULE

SECTION 1. FDE 3.02 (17) is created to read:

FDE 3.02 (17) Violating or attempting to violate any term, provision, or condition of any order of the board.

The rules adopted in this order shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register pursuant to s. 227.22 (intro.), Stats.
