SOCIAL WORK EXAMINATIONS

SFC 5.01 Examination.

Note: Chapter SFC 5 was created as an emergency rule effective April 26, 1993.

SFC 5.01 Examination. (1) An applicant for a certificate as a social worker, advanced practice social worker, independent social worker or independent clinical social worker shall pass all parts of the examination required by the social worker section, unless the applicant is exempt from the examination requirement.

(2) An applicant for a certificate as a social worker shall successfully complete the examination consisting of the Wisconsin statutes and rules examination and an examination approved by the section.

(3) An applicant for a certificate as an advanced practice social worker shall successfully complete the examination consisting of the Wisconsin statutes and rules examination and an examination approved by the section.

(4) An applicant for a certificate as an independent social worker shall successfully complete the examination consisting of the Wisconsin statutes and rules examination and an examination approved by the section.

(5) An applicant for a certificate as an independent clinical social worker shall successfully complete the examination consisting of the Wisconsin statutes and rules examination and an examination approved by the section.
