ORDER

An order of the Chiropractic Examining Board to create Chir 3.07 relating to professional liability insurance requirements for chiropractors.

Analysis prepared by the Department of Regulation and Licensing.

ANALYSIS

Statutes authorizing promulgation: ss. 15.08 (5) (b) and 227.11 (2), Stats., and s. 446.02 (8), Stats., as created by 1993 Wisconsin Act 31.

Statutes interpreted: s. 446.02 (8), Stats.

In this proposed rule-making order, the Chiropractic Examining Board complies with the statutory directive in 1993 Wisconsin Act 31 which creates s. 446.02 (8), Stats., to promulgate a rule establishing the minimum amount of professional liability insurance each chiropractor practicing in Wisconsin is required to have in effect. The proposed rule sets the minimum insurance limits at \$100,000 per occurrence, \$300,000 for all occurrences in one year.

TEXT OF RULE

SECTION 1. Chir 3.07 is created to read:

Chir 3.07 PROFESSIONAL LIABILITY INSURANCE. Every chiropractor practicing in the state of Wisconsin shall have professional liability insurance coverage in effect at all times in the amount of at least \$100,000 for each occurrence and \$300,000 for all occurrences in one year. The board shall conduct random audits of chiropractors licensed and practicing in this state, and institute disciplinary proceedings against any chiropractor who fails to submit proof that he or she has insurance coverage meeting the minimum limits required by this section.
