#### **ORDER**

An order of the Medical Examining Board to repeal Med 8.08 (3); to amend Med 8.07 (2) (i) and chapter Med 17 (title); and to create Med 17.06 relating to standards for dispensing and prescription orders.

# **ANALYSIS**

Statutes authorizing promulgation: ss. 15.08 (5) (b), 227.11 (2), 448.05 (5) (a) and 448.40, Stats.

Statutes interpreted: ss. 448.03 (2) (e) and 448.05 (5) (a), Stats.

In this proposed rule-making order the Medical Examining Board is amending and creating various administrative rules to define the delegation of prescription activities to physician assistants, professional nurses and ancillary health care personnel.

Section Med 8.07 (2) (i) is amended to allow physician assistants to prepare written prescription orders for controlled substances.

Section Med 8.08 (3) is repealed in order to permit physician assistants to prescribe controlled substances.

Section Med 17.06 is created to define what procedures and steps must be taken by a physician who delegates the preparing of written prescriptions to professional nurses and ancillary health care personnel.

#### **TEXT OF RULE**

SECTION 1. Med 8.07 (2) (i) is amended to read:

Med 8.07 (2) (i) Preparing written prescription orders for drugs, other than controlled substances as defined in s. 161.01 (4), Stats., if specifically directed to do so by the supervising physician and in accordance with procedures specified in s. Med 8.08 (2).

SECTION 2. Med 8.08 (3) is repealed.

SECTION 3. Chapter Med 17 (title) is amended to read:

# STANDARDS FOR DISPENSING AND PRESCRIBING DRUGS

SECTION 4. Med 17.06 is created to read:
