





ORDER

An order of the Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board to amend Figure 5.02 and Figure 5.06 relating to the syllabus for instruction for the practitioner license and for the manicurist license in schools licensed under s. 440.62, Stats., to include the topic of artificial nails in the syllabus for each license.

Analysis prepared by the Department of Regulation and Licensing.

ANALYSIS

Statutes authorizing promulgation: ss. 15.08 (5) (b), 227.11 (2) and 440.62 (5) (b), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: s. 440.62 (5) (b), Stats.

In this proposed rule-making order, the Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board amends Figures 5.02 and 5.06 which currently do not specify that the manicuring portion of the practitioner instruction syllabus or the syllabus for the manicurist instruction syllabus include the topic of artificial nails. Because artificial nails are now a major part of the practice of manicuring, minimally competent practice requires a basis of education, training and experience in the topic. The amendment to the rules will permit the board to include the topic on the licensing examinations, and to require minimal competence in the practice as a condition of licensure.


