SECTION 1. ILHR 127.06(3) is created to read:

ILHR 127.06(3) A claimant who is claiming extended benefits under s. 108.141, Stats., shall, in addition to complying with the requirements for extended benefits, comply with any requirements imposed by the department under subs. (1) and (2). A claimant who fails to comply with the requirements under this subsection shall be ineligible for benefits until the claimant has again worked within at least 4 subsequent weeks and earned wages equal to at least 4 times his or her extended weekly benefit rate.

SECTION 2. ILHR 132.06 is repealed.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This rule shall take effect on January 1, 1995.
