# ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD REPEALING AND RECREATING RULES

IN THE MATTER of repealing s. NR 10.01(1)(a) and and repealing and recreating s. NR 10.01(1)(b), (g) and (u)1 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code relating to the 1994 migratory game bird season.

### Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

Statutory authority: ss. 29.085, 29.174(3) and 227.11(2)(a), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: ss. 29.085, 29.102, 29.174(1) and (2), Stats.

The proposed rules establish the regulations for the 1994 migratory game bird season. The significant regulations are:

Ducks. The state is divided into two zones each with 40-day seasons. The season south of U.S. Highway 10 begins at noon October 1 and continues through October 9 and, following a 7-day closed period, reopens October 17 and continues through November 16. The season north of U.S. Highway 10 begins at noon October 1 and continues through November 9. The daily bag in both zones is 3 ducks, including one canvasback for the entire 40 days in the north and from October 22 through November 16 in the south.

Canada Geese. The state is apportioned into 3 goose hunting zones: Horicon, Collins and Exterior. Other special goose management subzones within the Exterior Zone include Brown County, Burnett County, New Auburn, Rock Prairie and the Mississippi River. Season lengths are: Collins Zone - 61 days; Horicon Zone - 80 days; Exterior Zone - 70 days; and Mississippi River Subzone - 70 days. The Burnett County and New Auburn subzones are closed to Canada goose hunting. The daily bag and possession limits for brant are changed.

Revises the dates for the 107-day falconry season.
