

ORDER OF THE OFFICE OF THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE AMENDING A RULE

To amend s. Ins 6.85 (4) (b) and Appendix 1 relating to the notice required regarding the right to file a complaint with the commissioner.

ANALYSIS PREPARED BY THE OFFICE OF THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE

This change will modify the notice of the right to file a complaint by
requiring that the insurer's address be included. In addition, if the insurer
has a toll free phone number, it must be listed.

Statutory authority: 631.28 and 601.41 (3), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: 631.28, Stats.

SECTION 1. Section Ins 6.85 (4) (b) and Appendix 1 are amended to read:

6.85 (4) (b) Allow-the-issuer-to-include-its-address-and Include the

issuer's address, toll free phone number, if available, and phone number in no

less than 12-point type and bold print.
