# Analysis Prepared by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation

STATUTORY AUTHORITY: ss. 85.16(1) and 85.22, Stats.

STATUTE INTERPRETED: s. 85.22, Stats.

General Summary of Rule. Comments have been received about the length of time it takes between when an applicant must begin the Section 16 application process and the time vehicles are ordered. The application process currently falls during the busiest time of the year for all parties involved in the process. This rule making will amend the application deadline from the first Monday in November to the first Monday in February. This change will condense the application process by 3 months and places the application process during a time of year which is more convenient to all parties involved.

<u>Fiscal Impact</u>. The Department estimates that there will be no fiscal impact on the liabilities or revenues of any county, city, village, town, school district, technical college district or sewerage district.

<u>Final Regulatory Flexibility Analysis</u>. This rule will have no adverse impact on small businesses.

# **TEXT OF RULE**

Under the authority vested in the state of Wisconsin, department of transportation, by ss. 85.16(1) and 85.22, Stats., the department of transportation hereby adopts an order to amend a rule interpreting s. 85.22, Stats., relating to the elderly and disabled transportation capital assistance program.

**SECTION 1**. Trans 2.015(1) and 2.05(1)(a) are amended to read:

Trans 2.015(1) "Application deadline" is the first Monday in November February.

Trans 2.05(1)(a) On or before the first Monday in November February, the applicant shall submit its completed application to the department's appropriate district office, except that the 1988 application deadline under this paragraph shall be April 4, 1988, rather than the first Monday in November 1987;
