II. PROPOSED RULE

SECTION 1. DHS 82.06 (2m) is amended to read:

FAMILY CARE INFORMATION AND REFERRAL. If the secretary of the department has certified that a resource center, as defined in s. DHS 10.13 (42), is available for the home under s. DHS 10.71, an adult family home shall provide information to prospective residents and refer residents and prospective residents to an aging and disability resource center as required under s. 50.033 (2r) to (2t), Stats., and s. DHS 10.73.

SECTION 2. DHS 82.06 (2m) (note) is repealed.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE: This rule shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register, as provided in s. 227.22 (2), Stats.
