- Check tightness test results (tank and line)	ATCP 93.100(3)c	
- Check meter calibration report	ATCP 93.100(3)c	
- Check all dispenser labeling.* Verify blend ratio at each dispenser if blending alternative fuels.	ATCP 94.300(1)	
- Check tank fill identification (use API Standard for gas with ethanol. Must be clearly identified - HB 44 3.30.UR.2.5)	API RP 1637	
- Stick tank for water (use Kolor Kut AND Sargel Paste) in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions	ATCP 93.100(3)c	
- Check "Clear and Bright"	ATCP 94.210(1)	
- Collect one sample for lab analysis if up to 50% ethanol. If more than 50%, do not collect sample.		
- Allow sale if clear and bright
