## Who may be eligible

If you are a Wisconsin resident, you may be eligible to obtain an occupational license if your operating privilege was revoked or suspended under the following circumstances:

- Under [Ch. 343 Wis. Stats.](#)
- A drug conviction under [s.961.50](#) (except juveniles).

- Nonpayment of child support under [s.767.303](#).
- A Habitual Traffic Offender (HTO) under [Ch. 351](#).

[Check your eligibility for an occupational license](#) if your license has been suspended or revoked.

## Who is not eligible

An occupational license cannot be issued:

- If you are not a resident of Wisconsin.
- If you are a juvenile who committed offenses under [Ch. 938](#).
- If you are under suspension for failing to pay a forfeiture (such as a traffic ticket or municipal citation).
- If your license has been canceled (rather than revoked or suspended).
- If you have never held a driver license.
- If you are eligible to reinstate your driver license after revocation or suspension.
- If you have two or more revocation or suspension cases from separate incidents in a one-year period.
- If you have not served all [mandatory waiting periods](#) for an occupational license.
- For a commercial driver license (CDL).

Occupational licenses authorizing operation of commercial motor vehicles cannot be issued, as required by the Motor Carrier Safety Improvement Act of 1999.
