



Hemlock Woolly Adelgid Regulated Areas



Hemlock Woolly Adelgid is an invasive insect that has caused widespread hemlock mortality in 20 eastern states. Along the west coast it does not reach damaging levels on western hemlock, but could be introduced on nursery stock. Wisconsin's exterior quarantine therefore restricts hemlock nursery stock from infested areas. For a complete list of regulated areas see ATCP 21, Appendix A.
