# Request a Payment Plan Online - It's Easy and Secure

- Request a new payment plan

## How does it work?

- One-time payments:
  - Individuals not registered for My Tax Account can pay online
  - For individuals and businesses registered for My Tax Account, logon to My Tax Account, select "Manage My Collection" and select "Pay" under "Pay My Balance"
- Periodic payments:
  - For individuals and businesses registered for My Tax Account, logon to My Tax Account, select "Manage My Collection", and select "New Plan" under "Request Payment Plan"
  - Individuals and businesses with an amount due that is not in collections can use this <a href="https://paper.com/application"><u>Application</u></a> to request a payment plan
  - o The forms to request a payment plan ⚠ (Form A-771) and to authorize EFT ☒ (Form A-771a) can also be found on our website. Print, complete, sign and mail the forms to the Compliance Bureau, Wisconsin Department of Revenue, PO Box 8901, Madison, WI 53708-8901. If you are unable to print the forms, you can ask to have them mailed by writing to us at the same address.

# Important:

Payment plan terms require that you file and pay all tax returns by their due date. As long as you honor these terms, we will not take other collection action. However, we will collect any refunds or payments due to you from the federal government, Wisconsin, and other states. We may also issue a tax warrant to secure your debt.
