White arrow boards provide motorists with directional information for qualifying tourist-related businesses, services or activities and are intended to direct tourists to the entrance of the business or onto a local road where the business is located. White arrow boards are only permitted on state highways nearest the facility. Only the name of the business is allowed on the sign.

# Criteria

Businesses qualify for white arrow boards if:

• The facility must be open to the public.

- Lodging facilities must have three or more units that are available for less than 30-day rental period.
- Businesses have the appropriate operating licenses to receive, maintain, or renew a permit.

Qualifying businesses may include, but are not limited to:

- Animal shelters
- Athletic fields, facilities
- Country clubs
- Cruises, boats
- Golf courses
- Exhibition, exposition center
- Horseback riding
- Hotel, motel, bed and breakfast
- Libraries
- Marinas
- Museums
- Theaters
- Schools
- Zoos
- Restaurants

# Businesses that DO NOT qualify include:

- Animal hospitals or game farms
- Ranches
- Barber, beauty shops
- Cemeteries
- Clinics, health clubs, hospitals
- Post offices
- Private clubs
- Sales, retail, wholesale
