CLOSE CALL: This June 2019 video is a vivid reminder of why it's so important to #MoveOver or #SlowDown for emergency vehicles with warning lights flashing. A Wisconsin state trooper conducted a traffic stop on I-94 in Dane County when a semi-truck crashed into the back of his patrol vehicle. Fortunately, there were no significant injuries. Wisconsin's "Move Over Law" requires drivers to move out of the lane closest to vehicles that are stopped along a highway with their warning lights activated. In 2019, there were 922 traffic convictions for violating the Move Over Law.
