EXECUTIVE ORDER #150

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin Be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Firefighter Stephen M. Smith of the Vandenbroek-Kaukauna Fire Department

WHEREAS, on December 20, 2021, Firefighter Stephen M. Smith passed away due to complications from COVID-19 contracted in the line of duty;

WHEREAS, Firefighter Stephen M. Smith devoted twenty-eight years of service to the Vandenbroek-Kaukauna Fire Department;

WHEREAS, Firefighter Stephen M. Smith was a family man who valued time spent with relatives and friends alike, and his loss is borne by his family, friends, community, and the people of Wisconsin collectively;

WHEREAS, Firefighter Stephen M. Smith will be remembered for his laughter, his love of the outdoors, and his ability to help others;

WHEREAS, the people of this State are forever grateful for his service and sacrifice; and

WHEREAS, services for Firefighter Stephen M. Smith will be held on Wednesday, December 29, 2021, in Kaukauna.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TONY EVERS, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the Laws of the State, hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds, and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on Wednesday, December 29, 2021, and ending at sunset on that date.
