#### **Rule Information**

The primary objective of the proposed rule is to simplify, reduce, modernize, and make more efficient the requirements for sources of air contaminants related to reporting, recordkeeping, testing, inspection and demonstrating compliance administered under ch. NR 439, Wis. Adm. Code, while remaining consistent with the federal Clean Air Act and retaining approvability by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. The proposed revisions will remove inconsistencies between state and federal rules. In addition, the department is proposing to update related sections of the NR 400 series to meet federal requirements and ensure consistency with the proposed revisions to ch. NR 439, Wis. Adm. Code.
