EL 10.01 Definitions.

EL 10.01 Definitions. In this chapter:

(1) “Student identification card” means a document or card that satisfies all of the following:

- (a) Is unexpired.
- (b) Contains the date of issuance.
- (c) Contains the name of the student to whom it is issued.
- (d) Contains the signature of the student to whom it is issued.
- (e) Contains a photograph that reasonably resembles the student to whom it is issued.
- (f) Contains an expiration date indicating that the card expires no later than 2 years after the date of issuance.
- (g) Is issued to a student who establishes that the student is

enrolled at the college that issued the card on the date that the card is presented.

(2) “Technical college” means a college that is a member of and governed by the Wisconsin technical college system.

EL 10.02 Wisconsin technical college system student identification cards for voting. A student identification card issued by a technical college is an acceptable form of identification under s. 5.02 (6m) (f), Stats., and may be presented by an elector obtaining a ballot pursuant to ss. 6.15 (2) (bm) and (3), 6.18, 6.79 (2), 6.82, 6.86 (1) and (2), 6.87, 6.875 (6), and 6.97, Stats.
