said road or any part thereof on a different route, if in the opinion of the said commissioners, a more favorable location can thereby be made; and provided, the said survey and location shall be made previous to the first of July next.

Copy of plat to be filed.

SECTION 2. Be it further enacted, That the said commissioners, are hereby required to make out a true and correct plat and field notes by them kept, in locating said road by the first of July next of the survey thereof; and that they make out and file one copy thereof in the office of the clerk of the board of county commissioners in each county through which said road may pass; and the clerk of said board of county commissioners in whose office said plat shall be filed, shall record the same.

Compensation.

SECTION 3. And be it further enacted, That the said commissioners be allowed two dollars and fifty cents per day, each, and all other hands necessarily employed for chain bearing, marking, &c., on said road be allowed any sum not exceeding one dollar and fifty cents each, per day, at the discretion of said commissioners; and that each of the counties through which said road may pass, shall pay an equal proportion of the expense of establishing the said road; agreeable to the distance that the said road may pass through the several counties.

## No. 28.

AN ACT to divorce Mary Williams, from her husband, Thomas Williams.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the council and house of representatives of the territory of Wisconsin, That the marriage contract heretofore existing between Mary Williams and her husband, Thomas Williams, be, and the same is hereby annulled and made void; and that all obligations arising from the said marriage contract, be, and the same are hereby made of no more force or effect than if the said contract had never existed.
