AN ACT in relation to Courts of Equity.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

Jurisdiction of courts of equity over corporations.

SEC. 1. That courts of equity shall have power to declare the charter of any corporation to be forfeited for any just cause, and shall possess and are hereby vested with the same power upon the subject of corporations, that is possessed by courts of common law jurisdiction.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

AN ACT to amend an act, entitled "an act to change the time of holding Courts in the Second Judicial District."

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

SEC. 1. All writs, summons, process, indictments, recognizances, and other proceedings in any of the courts, in the first section of the act of which this is amendatory, mentioned, which shall have been instituted since the first day of September last, or may hereafter be instituted, shall be returnable at the term of such court to be begun and holden next after the day of the issuing of the same, any thing in the second section of said act contained, to the contrary notwithstanding.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
