

ernment, to be held on the first Tuesday of March next, be so amended that said first town meetings be held on the first Tuesday of April next.

SEC. 2. The first meeting of the board of supervisors in and for the county [counties] now under the county system of government, shall be held at the several county seats of said counties, on the first Monday of June next. Time of meet- ing.

SEC. 3. The clerks of boards of county commissioners in those counties in which the commissioners have not met in pursuance of the act of which this is amendatory to divide their several counties into towns, shall, within ten days after the receipt of this act, call a special meeting for that purpose. Duty of clerks.

SEC. 4. The secretary of state is hereby required to forward by mail to the clerks of the board of county commissioners a certified copy of this act, immediately after its passage. Sec'y to for- ward.

Chap 13.

NELSON DEWEY.

An Act to provide for laying out certain roads therein named.

Chap 14.

THE People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. E. R. Steves, H. Wedge, and Wiram Knowlton are hereby appointed commissioners to lay out and establish a state road through part of the county of St. Croix, the county of Chippewa, and a part of the county of Crawford, commencing in the county of St. Croix, in town twenty-nine north, range nineteen west, where the county road leading from the mouth of lake St. Croix to the Falls of St. Croix, strikes the section corner between sections twenty-nine, thirty, thirty-one, and thirty-two, thence on the most direct and feasible route to Carson and Eaton's Com'rs to locate road through eos. of Crawford, Chippewa, and St. Croix.
