SEC. 2. If any lots or lands shall remain unsold, it shall be the duty of the Treasurer to return a delinquent list to the Clerk of said village, on or before the fourth Monday of February, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-one.

Chap. 12.

An Act to change the name of the town of Elizabeth, in St. Croix county.

The People of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Name changed.

SECTION 1. The town of Elizabeth in the county of St. Croix, shall hereafter be called and known by the name of "Prescott."

Chap. 13.

An Act to appropriate to J. & W. H. Carey the sum therein named.

The People of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated to J. & W. H. Carey, one hundred and eighteen dollars and eighty-one cents, for clothing for state prisoners up to December second, eighteen hundred and fifty, to be paid out of any funds in the State Treasury not otherwise appropriated.
