Wil-Commissioners cox be and they are hereby appointed commissioners to lay out appointed and establish a State road from some point on Fox river, near Route. Appleton, in the county of Outagamie, to Muckwa on Wolf river, and from thence to Plover in Portage county.

SEC. 2. The said commissioners shall receive, for the laying County Superout said road, such compensation as the Supervisors of the sev-termine comeral counties through which the said road shall run, may determine: Provided, that no monies in the State treasury shall Proviso. be appropriated therefor.

() quarter line of section [--] in the town of Bloomingdale, in the county of Winnebago, thence north, on the most feasible route, to the village of Winneconna.

SEC. 2. The said commissioners shall receive for the laying County Superof said road such compensation as the supervisors of the said compensation.
