An Act to change the time for making seesements and collections of taxes in the Chap. 252 county of Portage

The People of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION I. The time for making the assessments upon Time changed property in said county is hereby changed from the time now fixed by the law of this State to the months of February in each year, and the time for the collection of taxes is hereby changed from the time now fixed by law to the month of April in each year. The town board of Supervisors to appoint one Supervisors and Assessor, and the Treasurer of each town in said county shall Treasurers. have the right to levy on property and sell the same by the above mentioned time as is now allowed by law for such purposes.

SEC. 2. This law to take effect from and after its passage.

## Chap. 258

There is hereby appropriated to Benton and Garfield, the sum of six hundred and seventy-six dollars and twenty-nine cents, for candles and stationery furnished the Legislative Assembly in 1839, to be paid out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, which shall be in full for principal and interest of said debt.
