Lac in Fond du Lac county, are hereby declared vacated, and the owners thereof may possess all the rights and privileges that they did, or would have possessed in relation thereto, had not the same been laid out into village lots.

Chap. 275 An Act to vacate a part of the Town Plat of the village of Westfield in Sauk county

All that part of the town plat of the village of Westfield in the county of Sauk, lying north of a line sixty-three rods south of the section line between sections one and twelve in township nine, north of range six east, and parallel with said line, except the east half of block fifty-five and blocks fifty-six and fifty-seven, is hereby vacated.

An Act to after the boundaries of the town of Calumet in Fond du Lac county

Chap. 276 The People of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The south half of town seventeen, range eighteen, the south half of town seventeen, range nineteen, the north half of town sixteen, range eighteen, and the north half of town sixteen, range nineteen, in Fond du Lac county, shall constitute the town of Calumet, and elections in said town shall be held at the School House in school district number two of said town.

Boundaries of SEC. 2. Town fifteen, range nineteen, and the south half of town sixteen, range nineteen, shall remain and constitute the town of Forest.

Boundaries of SEC. 3. The south half of town sixteen and sections one, two, three, four, five and six of town fifteen, range eighteen, shall constitute the town of Taychedah.
