An act to change the time of holding the Circuit Court in Calumet County.

Chap 266

The people of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The November term of the circuit court for the county of Calumet, shall hereafter be on the Tuesday when term of succeeding the third Monday in November in each year, instead of the time heretofore required by law.

Sec. 2. So much of any and all former acts as conflict

with the provisions of this act, is hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

An Act for the relief of William Archer,

Chap 267

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. That Samuel Thompson a justice of the peace in the town of Lisbon, county of Waukesha, be and to refine he is hereby directed to refund to William Archer the samount of fine collected by said Thompson from said Archer on the twenty-seventh day of January last, deducting the amount of cost incurred in the case in which said fine was inflicted: Provided, however, That if said justice shall have paid over the said fine to the town treasurer or any other person authorized to receive the same, then and in that case, the person or officer who may now have said amount in his hands shall pay the same over as above provided.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
