An Act to grant one copy of the Revised Statutes, Laws, Journals, and Legislative Documents of this state to Beloit College and other literary institutions.

Chap 381

The people of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The librarian is hereby authorized to deliver to Beloit College and to all other incorporated academies and literary institutions of this state, ^{To deliver books} having a library of three hundred volumes, one copy of the revised statutes, one copy of the session laws of each session of the legislature, one copy of the journals of the senate and assembly of each session, one copy each of the journals of two constitutional conventions, one copy each of all documents printed by order of the legislature of this state, and one copy each of the revised statutes, laws, and journals of the council and house of representatives of the territory of Wisconsin, and the reports of the decisions of the supreme court of this state: *Provided*, ^{Proviso.} Twenty-five copies of each document and book be retained in the library.

SEC. 2. The librarian shall deliver to said colleges one copy each of the laws, journals, and other documents hereafter printed by order of the legislature of this state, ^{Future publications.} within ninety days after publication.

SEC. 3. The said statutes, laws, journals and documents may be delivered to any person authorized by the president or principal of said institutions. ^{To whom delivered.}
