Chap 442

The people of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to E. B. Kelsey, out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of sixty-two dollars and fifty cents, in full for writing done during the months of January and February for commissioners of school and university lands.
