An Act to provide for the appointment of commissioners to select and appraise school Chap 490 lands.

The people of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly do enact as follows:

Section 1. The governor is hereby authorized and cm-governor to appoint from one to three commissioners to se-point commissioners and appraise whatever may remain to be selected of the five hundred thousand acres of land granted to this

state by act of Congress, approved Sept. 4th, 1841.

SEC. 2. The said commissioners so appointed, shall, before entering upon the duties required of them by this act, take and subscribe an oath of office as required in section twenty-eight, of article four, of the constitution, before some person authorized to administer oaths, and transmit the same to the governor, who shall cause the same to be filed in the office of the secretary of state.

SEC. 3. Said commissioners shall act under the direction of the governor in making selections of said lands, To make return and shall make monthly returns of such lands selected by them to the governor, they shall also make returns to the land offices of the district in which any lands selected by them are situated, as soon after such selection as may be practicable.

Sec. 4. Said commissioners, in appraising said lands, shall be governed by the provisions of sections four and How appraisers five of an act of the legislature entitled "an act provid-governed, ing for the appraisal and subdivisions of the school and

university lands," approved August 12th, 1848.

Sec. 5. The said commissioners shall each receive three dollars for each and every day actually and necessarily compensation spent in performing the duties required by this act, and they shall certify under oath the number of days so spent by them.
