An Act relating to Plank Roads.

The people of the State of Wisconsin represented in Chap. 52. Senate and Assembly do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Every person who shall forcibly or fraudulently pass any toll gate erected on any plank road within this state, without having paid the legal toll, or who shall, to avoid the payment of legal toll, with his carriage or tempting to ehorse, or other vehicle or animal liable to toll, turn out of rold payment of such road, or pass any gate thereon, on ground adjacent thereto, and enter again on such read, or who shall, for the purpose of avoiding the rayment of toll, misrepresent to any gate keeper as to the place where he came on to the plank road, or as to the distance which he has traveled
