An Act to appropriate to Carpenter & Tenney the sum therein named.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, to Carpenter & Tenney the sum of one hundred and twenty dollars, in full for 6000 charts ordered by the Senate and House by resolution.

Chap. 58.

An Act appropriating to A. & J. Manning the sum therein named.

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to Abraham and Thomas Manning, to be paid out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of twenty dollars, in full for work and labor in and about the capital up to January 17th, 1852.

Chap. 59.

An Act to authorize the construction of a dam across the Manitowoc River.

The people of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Authorized to
build dam.

SECTION 1. Charles Klingholz and Richard Klingholz, their associates, successors, heirs, and assigns, are hereby authorized to erect and maintain a dam across the Manitowoc river, on the north-east quarter of section number sixteen of township nineteen, north of range number twenty-three, east of the fourth principal meridian, in the county of Manitowoc, and to make use of the water of said river for hydraulic purposes: *Provided*, That the construction of said dam shall in no way infringe upon the rights of other persons not herein named.

Proviso.

SEC. 2. The said dam shall not exceed ten feet in height ^{Height of dam.} from the water-mark, and shall be so constructed as to admit of the passage of all descending rafts and water crafts which shall at all times be entitled to pass said dam free of all charges to the owner or owners of said rafts or water crafts.

SEC. 3. The legislature may at any future time alter or amend this act, when it shall be deemed proper to provide for the improvement of the Manitowoc river.

An Act to amend an act entitled, "an act to incorporate the Potosi and Dodgeville Rail Road Company," approved February the 10th, 1851,

Chap. 61.

The people of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. An act entitled an act to incorporate the Potosi and Dodgeville Rail Road Company, approved February the 10th, 1851, is hereby so amended that section nine of said act shall be so construed that the said Potosi and Dodgeville Rail Road Company shall have power to make, construct, and erect, all such warehouses, machine shops, carriages, cars, and other works and appendages as may be necessary for the convenience of said company, to the use of the said rail road, and to connect the same with ^{Act amended.}
