No religious test requisite.

SEC. 7. No religious test or qualification shall be required of any trustee or officer of said corporation, nor of any student of said institution.

Sec. 8. This act may be amended or altered by any fu-

ture legislature.

Chap. 85.

An Act appropriating money to the Members of the Legislature.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Schate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated to each member of the senate and assembly the sum of seventy-five dollars to be paid out of any moneys in the state treasury.

SEC. 2. There is hereby appropriated to the chief clerk of the senate the sum of seven hundred and twenty dollars, and to the chief clerk of the assembly the sum of six hundred and fifteen dollars, to be paid out of any moneys in the state treasury.

SEC. 3. There is hereby appropriated to Timothy Burns, Lieutenant Governor, the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars, to be paid out of any moneys in the state treasury, and to the speaker of the assembly, the sum of seventy-five

dollars.

SEC. 4. There is hereby appropriated to the sergeant-atarms of the senate, and to the sergeant-at-arms of the assembly, each, the sum of four hundred dollars, to be paid out of any moneys in the state treasury.
