not exceed the sum of ten dollars to each newspaper publishing the same.

An Act to extend the [time] for the collecting of Taxes in the Town of Dane, County of Dane.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Chap. 3. Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The time for collecting the taxes in the town of Dane, in the county of Dane, is hereby extended thirty days beyond the time now required by law; and the treasurer of said town shall have the s me right to levy on property and sell the same, within such time so extended, as is now allowed by law for such purposes.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its

passage.

Approved, February 7, 1853.

An Act to fix the time for holding the February Term of the Circuit Court of Milwaukee County.

Chap. 4.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The circuit court for the county of Milwaukee, to be held on the second Monday of February (the fourteenth), in the year one thousand eight hundred and firty-three, shall be and is hereby deferred and postponed to the first Monday in May of said year, the time for holding the regular spring term of said court.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its

passage.

An Act to incorporate the Wisconsin State Agricultural Society.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Chap. 5. Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The "Wisconsin State Agricultural Society" Created a body is hereby declared a body politic and corporate, and by corporate. that name it shall be known in all courts and places whatsoever.
