

Chap. 84.

AN ACT to provide for the purchase of the Reports of the Supreme Court.

Published, May 4, 1854.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Governor to purchase reports.

§ 1. The governor is hereby authorized to purchase four hundred copies of the reports of the supreme court for the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty-three, at a price not exceeding four dollars per volume.

Mode of distribution.

§ 2. The copies purchased under the provisions of this act shall be disposed of as follows: one copy to each of the judges of the supreme and circuit courts, one copy to the clerk of the circuit court of each county in the state organized for judicial purposes, one copy to each of the administrative state officers, to be delivered over to their successors in office, one copy for exchange with each state of the United States, one for each of the departments of the United States government, and the remainder to be deposited in the state library.

§ 3. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

AN ACT for the relief of William W. Brown.

Published, May 8, 1854.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly do enact as follows:

§ 1. The governor of this state is hereby authorized to audit and settle upon just and equitable principles, the account of William W. Brown, for services as agent of this state in going to the city of Washington, and procuring
