

Chapter 32.

An Act to change the name of Henry Lewis Bromm to Henry Lewis Grimm.

The People of the state of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. The name of Henry Lewis Bromm, of the town of Mishicot, and county of Manitowoc, is hereby changed to Henry Lewis Grimm, and by the last mentioned name, he shall hereafter be known and recognized in law and equity and otherwise.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage. *Provided*, That said Henry Lewis Bromm shall file in the office of the secretary of state, his written assent to the change of his name as provided in this act.

Chapter 33.

An Act to provide for holding an additional term of the Circuit Court in Grant county, and such other special terms in the Fifth Circuit as the Judge thereof may direct.

The People of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. In addition to the terms of the circuit court of Grant county, as now provided by law, there shall annually be held a special term of said court, for the transaction of such business in law and equity, as may be brought before the court, as does not require the intervention of a jury.

SEC. 2. Such term shall be held at the court house in said county, on the first Monday in August in each year.

SEC. 3. The judge of the fifth judicial circuit is hereby authorized to hold one or more special terms in any county in his circuit, at such times as he may direct. A notice to the sheriff of such county five days before the time
