

Chapter 38.

[Published April 23.]

An Act to appropriate to the town of Sullivan the sum of seventy-two dollars (\$72,00) out of the income of the School Fund.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the town of Sullivan, Jefferson county, and State of Wisconsin, to be drawn by the superintendent of common schools of said town the sum of seventy-two dollars (\$72,00) out of the income of the school fund, that was not drawn and which belonged to said town for the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty four. Appropriation

SEC. 2. Said sum when drawn, shall be apportioned among the common school districts of said town as they existed at the time the same was due. How apportioned.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

Chapter 39.

[Published April 12, 1855.]

An Act to change the name of Elizabeth Brooks and Virginia Brooks.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The name of Mrs. Elizabeth Brooks, of Whitewater, in Walworth county, is hereby changed to Elizabeth Drichman, and the name of Virginia Brooks, infant daughter of the said Elizabeth Brooks and of Fletcher Brooks, is hereby changed to Virginia Drichman.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect as soon after its passage as the said Elizabeth Brooks shall file in the office of the town clerk of Whitewater, her written consent to the provisions of said act.
