

## CHAPTER 29.

*Published April 28.*

An Act to change the name of Harriet Cowles and her infant daughter Mary Emma Virginia Cowles.

*The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :*

SECTION 1. The name of Harriet Cowles of the town <sup>Name changed</sup> of Baraboo, in the county of Sauk, is hereby changed to Harriet Chapman, and the name of her infant daughter, Mary Emma Virginia Cowles, is hereby changed to Mary Emma Virginia Chapman, and by the last mentioned names they shall respectively be hereafter known and recognized.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 30.

*Published March 25.*

An Act concerning evidence.

*The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :*

SECTION 1. Copies of any record, plat, file, paper or memorandum, of the purchase or entry of any land made or kept in any land office of the United States located in this state, when certified by the register of the land office, having the charge or custody thereof, in like form as is by statute required as to other records, plats, files or papers, shall be, in or before any court or tribunal, evidence of the matters or things so certified.

Copies of record, &c., certified by register deemed evidence.

SEC. 2. This act shall be printed by the state printer immediately after the passage thereof, and when so printed shall take effect.
