AN ACT to change the name of Lemuel Preston Richardson to Lemuel Preston Randall.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Name changed
and heirship es-
tablished of L.P.
Richardson.

§ 1. The name of Lemuel Preston Richardson of the town of Nepeuskin, in the county of Winnebago, is hereby changed to Lemuel Richardson Randall, by which latter name the said person shall be hereafter called and known in popular nomenclature in law.

§ 2. The said Lemuel R. Randall shall be esteemed and taken in law to be the child and heir at law of Philester Randall, of said county of Winnebago, and the mutual obligations of parent and child shall exist and pertain as fully between the foster parent and foster child mentioned herein, as in the case of natural parentage.

§ 3. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

AN ACT to repeal Chapter 12, of the General Laws of 1855.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Chap. 12, G. L. of
1855, repealed.

§ 1. Chapter twelve of the General Laws of A. D. one thousand eight hundred and fifty-five, entitled an "act to change the name of Anner Morley to Emma Carpenter," approved February 17, 1855, is hereby repealed.

§ 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
