CHAPTER 37.

AN ACT in addition to chapter eighty-six of the Revised Statutes, entitled "Of alienation by deed, of the proof and recording of conveyances, and the cancelling of mortgages."

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Deeds executed within this state, of lands Deeds, how or any interest in lands therein, owned by a corporation signed. created under the laws of this state, shall be signed by the president or other authorized officer of the corporation, sealed with the seal of the corporation, and countersigned by the secretary or clerk thereof; and the per son signing such deed may acknowledge the execution the reof before any officer authorized by law to take acknowledge ments; and every such deed shall be admitted to record a in the same manner and with like force and effect as if the same had been executed in conformity with the pro-How recorded visions of chapter eighty-six of the revised statutes, entitled "Of alienation by deed, of the proof and recording of conveyances, and the cancelling of mort-gages."
