

## CHAPTER 109.

[Published March 16, 1860.]

AN ACT to provide for the purchase of certain copies of Webster's Dictionary, for the supply of deficient school districts of the State.

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. The State Superintendent of Public In- Authority to struction, with the consent and approval of the Governor, purchase dic- is hereby authorized to purchase, on behalf of the State, tionaries, six hundred copies of Webster's Unabridged Dictionary of the English language, (provided that the price paid Price shall not exceed four dollars for each copy,) to supply the deficient school districts of the State.

SEC. 2. Such dictionaries, when purchased, shall be How distribu- distributed in the manner provided in chapter 22, of the ted. General Laws of 1858, and in section 2, of chapter 138, of the General Laws of 1859, and shall be held and used by the several districts receiving the same, as provided in section 8, of said chapter 138, aforesaid.

SEC. 3. There is hereby appropriated, out of the in- Appropriation come of the school fund, a sum of money sufficient to pay for the dictionaries provided for in this act, to be paid out of the first moneys received into the school fund income, after the apportionment of the present year; and the sum so paid shall be deducted from the amount subject to apportionment for the year next following after the payment for said dictionaries; and the State Superintendent of Public Instruction shall certify to the State Treasurer the amount of such expenditure and deduction.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
